

Construction Update
Middlesex – US 2 Bridge Replacement
IM 089-2(41)

Project Location: Bridge 55 is located on US 2 in Middlesex approximately 1.9 miles east of the intersection of US 2/VT 100B and spans over Interstate 89 and the New England Central Railroad (NECR) line. This is a multi-year project with construction starting in 2016 and completion scheduled for 2018.

I-89 Lane Closures –Daily single lane closures on I-89 Northbound and Southbound near the project can be expected throughout the week. Construction crews will be excavating within the median as part of the bridge project. Reduce speed and use caution when driving through the project. Traffic delays can be expected.

The posted speed limit will be reduced to 55 mph within the I-89 lane closures.

Week of May 1, 2017

There are multiple active construction operations currently underway on this project. Please use caution when driving through the project on I-89 and US 2.

Pier 2 for the new bridge will be located within the I-89 median. Excavation within the median for the pier footing is expected to start this week. Single lane closures can be expected daily on I-89 throughout the week.

Continued construction of pier 1 and the footing for abutment 2 will also occur this week.

US 2 will be reduced to one lane throughout the entire project with alternating one-way traffic maintained. Flaggers will be present to assist with maintaining traffic flow.

Traffic –Traffic delays can be expected this week on US 2 and I-89.

It is illegal in VT to use any handheld portable electronic devices while driving. The law carries fines of up to \$200 with points assessed if the violation occurs in a work zone.
